

THAMES VALLEY CROSS-COUNTRY LEAGUE
SANDHURST JOGGERS

Location: Hawley Common, two and a half miles south-west of Camberley, close to junction 4a on the M3 (see map below).

Access is off the A327 (Minley Road) between the A30 and M3 junction 4a.

- **From the M3 (J4a)** take the A327 northwest towards Yateley & Reading for a little under a mile, then turn **right** onto a minor road... **or**...
- **From the A30** take the A327 southeast towards the M3 (J4a), Cove & Farnborough for just over a mile (keep left at the first roundabout), then turn **left** onto a minor road...
- This road will be marked (from either direction) by yellow runner+arrow sign. It also has a large sign “*Hawley Lake Sail Training*” and a white sign “*Army Training Land*”.
- Follow the yellow arrows for just over a mile, passing an army depot and the sailing club on the right, through a barrier and up a short steep hill.
- There is ample parking close to the start/finish.

If you are using modern technology to get there the nearest postcode is GU17 9LP. However this is the army complex at Gibraltar Barracks & Minley Manor (“Hornley Common” on the map below), which is actually 2/3 mile northwest of the turning off the A327. The OS Grid Ref of the turning off the A 327 is SU 830 574

There are no changing facilities at the start/finish, but car parking is very close. There are no toilets. Refreshments will be provided at the finish.

The course is through woodland and heath on gravel roads, dirt tracks and footpaths. You will encounter hills, rough terrain and probably mud. It is suitable for spikes.

Numbers will be issued to club scorers on the day.
